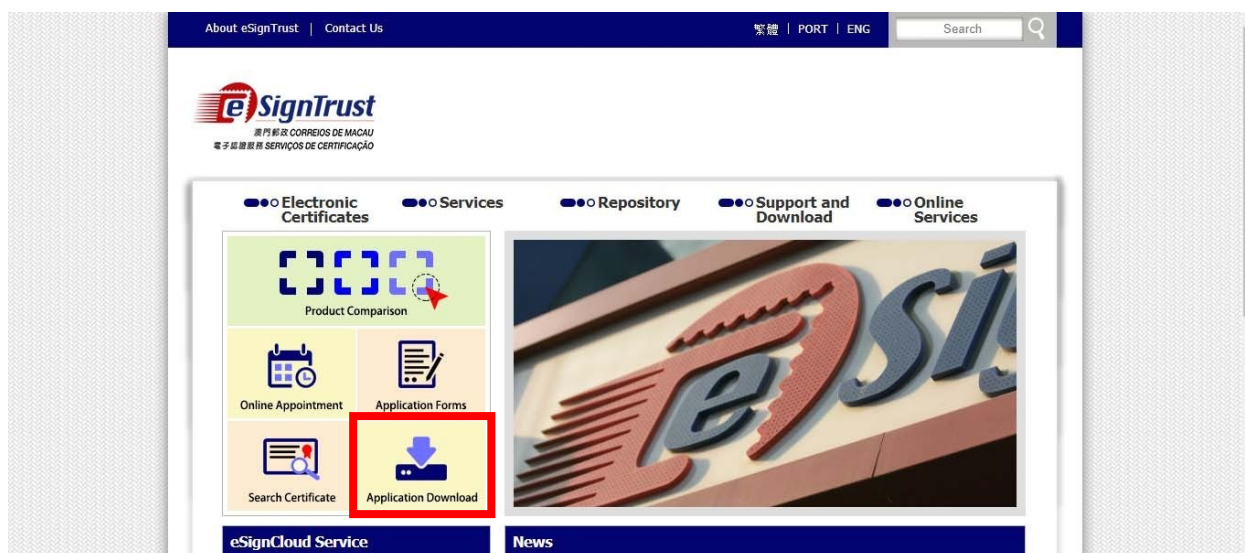



1. Select “Select PDF file” to open the PDF file that has the Electronic Signature(s) to be verified.
2. Then select “Verify signatures in PDF file” to verify.



3. The verification results will be shown at the following blank area, including the amount of the signatures in PDF, signer name, organization or company, signature field name and the verified result of the signature.



4. Click “Show subject” to display the details of the certification of the signature.
